Just 3 weeks to go for you to take action on this! We will no longer be sending general texts reminders after half term. Reminders will only be sent through the School Gateway App.

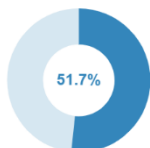

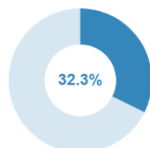
Current website usage

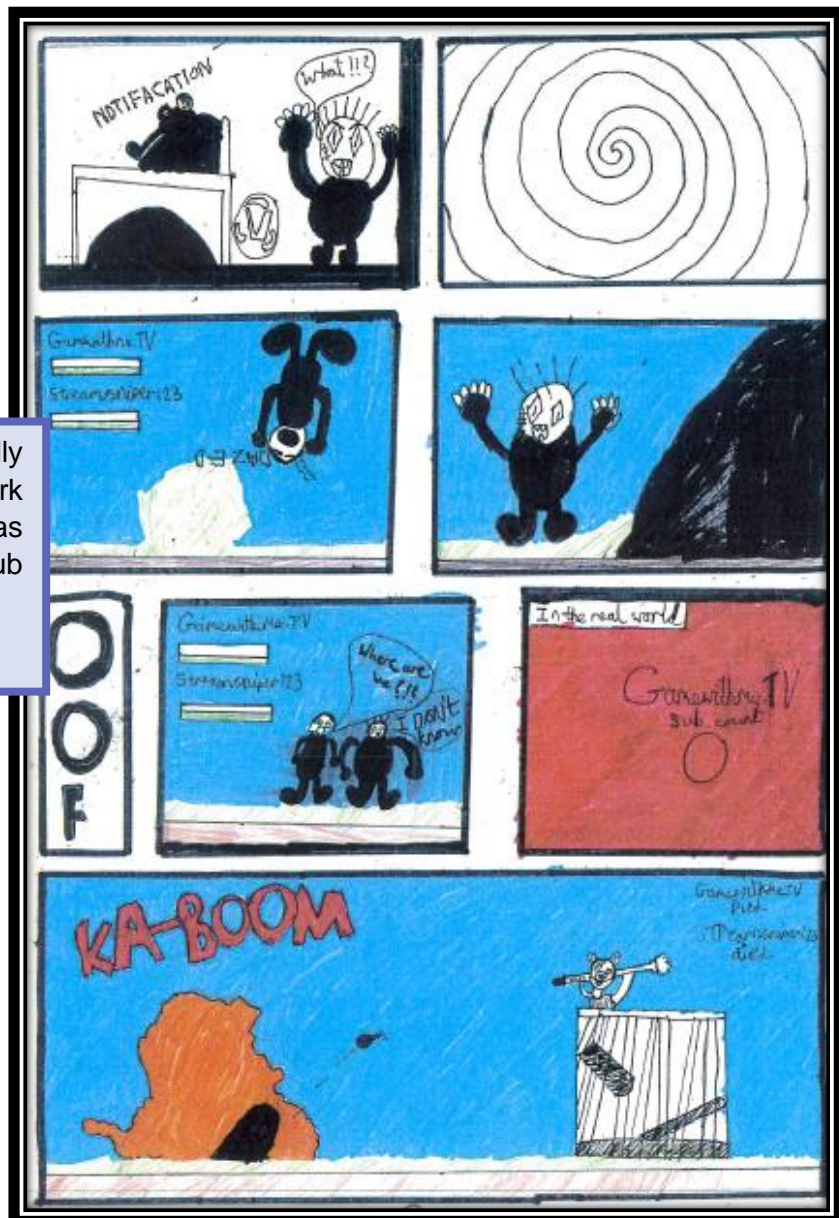
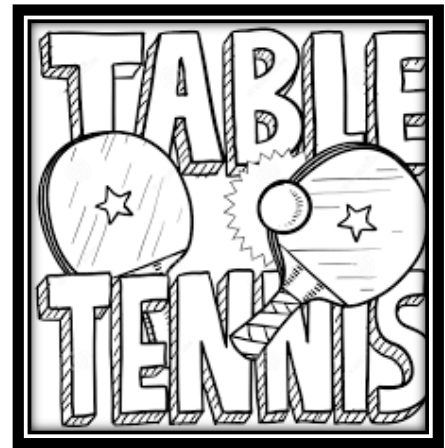
Table Tennis
