Re: Collection of Free School Meal Lunches

We have a duty of care to provide all our children eligible for a Free school Meal with a dinner at lunchtime during term time, even when the school is required to close.

Obviously the situation regarding this provision is changing rapidly. The government announced yesterday that they would be introducing a voucher system to use at supermarkets. However, as this is not in place, we will proceed with our plan to provide term-time meals to all children eligible, for you to cook a hot meal at home daily.

Our catering provider *Nourish* has prepared packs which contain groceries for eight days – this will take you to the Easter holidays. From then on, we hope to know more from government and will keep you informed.

Collection of Packs


Please collect your pack from St. Peter's Junior School reception area between the hours of 1pm and 4pm on Friday 20th March. Upon collection, you will need to:

- Bring a carrier bag with you for groceries
- Bring ID with your name (ideally photo ID). If your are self-isolating and intend to send a family member / friend, please ask that person to have your ID on their person.

A signature will be required upon collection to confirm receipt.
