Re. Cornonavirus Update

Keyworker/Vulnerable Familiy Provision

After yesterday's announcement by the Prime Minister, we are now making preparations and are trying to follow the government guidelines to provide a childcare service to our keyworkers. This is 'in the planning' right now.

We will be joining with Callis Grange Infants, Ramsgate Holy Trinity Primary and Palm Bay Primary to provide this service for any of our keyworker children who need it.

The provision will be at Palm Bay Primary School. This is due to the school having the best and largest outside playing spaces, as well as access to the beach – it is so important that if a number of children will be requiring this childcare that we offer as much fresh air and outdoor learning / playing as possible to avoid the spread of the virus.

I want to be very clear that this provision will only be available to keyworkers, and we are awaiting the definitive list from government. You must:

- Be in a household where BOTH parents are key workers or from a single parent household and a keyworker
- Have no one else in the household that can look after your child
- Require childcare. If you do not require it, we ask that stay away from a school setting for the safety
 of all.

If you or a family member are self-isolating, due to yourself, your child or a family member having symptoms, we will not be able to have your child at school.

If you fall into this set of categories and have made us aware by telephone today, a questionnaire will follow tomorrow, asking for further details and what childcare provision you will require. This will come to you via email from *Survey Monkey*.

Our vulnerable families will be identified and contacted away from this process.
