

Request for Key Worker Childcare at Palm Bay Primary School during Coronavirus Situation

Dear Keyworker Parents and Carers of children enrolled at St Peters-in-Thanet Junior School and Ramsgate Holy Trinity Primary School.

As you have been informed by Mrs Price and Mr Hunter-Whitehouse, our three schools are working together as a local hub, in order to continue to provide childcare over the Easter holidays, for the families who need it the most due to this unprecedented situation.

We look forward to welcoming your child/children to Palm Bay, where I can assure you we will do everything we can to make them feel safe, settled, happy and part of the school community.

In order for me to organise appropriate staffing rotas, we need to know as far as possible in advance how many children we will be caring for each day. We also need to make sure we hold appropriate information on the children who are not enrolled at Palm Bay (e.g. allergies, medical needs and emergency contact details). We would therefore be very grateful if you would complete the form below; please note that this information with be treated confidentiality and will be destroyed once you no longer require childcare at Palm Bay.

Once we have received this form from you, we will then send you a text to a weekly survey, where you can book childcare for the following week. I appreciate that, because some of you work unpredictable shift patterns, it may not always be possible to let us know in advance.
