Talking to a child worried about coronavirus

If your child is anxious or worried about coronavirus (COVID-19), there are things you can do to help.

There is a lot of uncertainty in the world at the moment, and there won't always be answers to the questions your children are asking, but there is help available for you to have these conversations with your child in a safe and open way.
