## A change of RE plans for next term:

During Term 4, we normally follow the Understanding Christianity unit - Salvation. The depth of the material shared in class, does not lend itself to home learning under the current climate; therefore, a condensed Salvation unit will deliver the Easter message in the last three weeks of term.



This allows for extra curriculum time in the first three weeks where we will learn about Humanism, not a religion but a belief.
