

iPad Parental Controls

You can enable and adjust Restrictions, also known as Parental Controls, on your child's iPad to prevent access to specific features or content.


Locate these settings by tapping Settings > General > Restrictions.



To Enable Restrictions, tap Enable Restrictions and enter a passcode.


Important: If you forget your restrictions passcode, you must restore the iPad software.





You can set restrictions for the following apps:

- Safari
- Camera (and apps that use the camera)
- FaceTime
- iTunes Store
- iBookstore
- Siri



You can also prevent access to specific content types.

We will not be using Messages or Facetime currently. We have restricted Facetime. If you are concerned about your

child using Messages, ensure no Apple ID is filled in the Messages box.



You can also stop your child playing online games.

If you decide to enable restrictions and enter a passcode it is important that you email the school with the passcode. We will not be able to make changes on the iPad or restore missing Apps without it.
