Usual reminders!

Dogs - Dogs are not allowed on the school premises. Please tie your dog up outside the school grounds without obstructing the entrances.

Labelling – Please ensure all of your child's clothes are clearly labelled. This helps us to return lost items swiftly back to their owner. We highly recommend the Stikins labels which can be ordered online at <u>www.stikins.co.uk</u> and please quote 21726 to raise funds for the school.

Parking – Remember the drop off zone in the morning is for a 1-minute turn around and should not be used for parking or to wait until your child is in school.

At the end of the day, please use the Thanet Wanderers car park if Grange Road is busy. Do not double park or park on the double yellow lines. Please respect the local residents.

Pencil cases – children do not need to bring in their own pencils and stationery as we provide everything they need. This stops any loved items being lost!

Walk home letters – If your child is in Year 5, please complete a 'walk home letter' if you give permission for them to leave school alone. Year 6 pupils will continue to have permission if their form was completed last year. If you have any changes you would like to make to your child's arrangements, please fill out a blue form in the foyer and hand it into the office.

Scooters/Bikes – Due to a Health and Safety risk, please support the school by NOT ALLOWING scooters and bikes to be used on either Callis or our school grounds, including the pathways, before or after school.

Home time – Please do not allow your children to play on the outdoor play equipment when they are leaving school.

School Payments and Messages – the School Gateway System

A reminder to pay for clubs and school dinners via our School Gateway system. A handy guide to set this up is available along with this newsletter, and further information is available on our website.

If you experience problems, please contact the school office. Please make sure you have notifications activated as we often message via this app.

School Meals

The cost for school dinners has now increased to **£2.70** per meal. Please note, any debt over **£10** will result in your child not being able to have any further meals until the debt is paid.

The menu is available on our website or from the office.

We all know that there is a real cost of living crisis right now and that some of our families' circumstances may have changed over the summer. If you receive certain benefits, you may be entitled to **Free School Meals.**

Not only does it provide a good meal for your child every day but it also means the school can access additional money to help with trips, visits and resources.

You can also pop into the office any morning and speak to Mrs. Hart and she will able to help you.
