craters on a crescent moon, the rings of Saturn and the moons of Jupiter, the Summer Triangle asterism - the stars Deneb, Vega and Altair in a large triangle shape, each in their own constellation - Cygnus, Lyra and Aquila and the Plough and the link to Polaris.

You do need to book for this event and there are 4 Sessions available - 5.00pm, 5.30pm, 6.00pm and 6.30pm each session lasting for 30 minutes and restricted to 15 groups per session.
