Please remember to return the completed forms to the office.

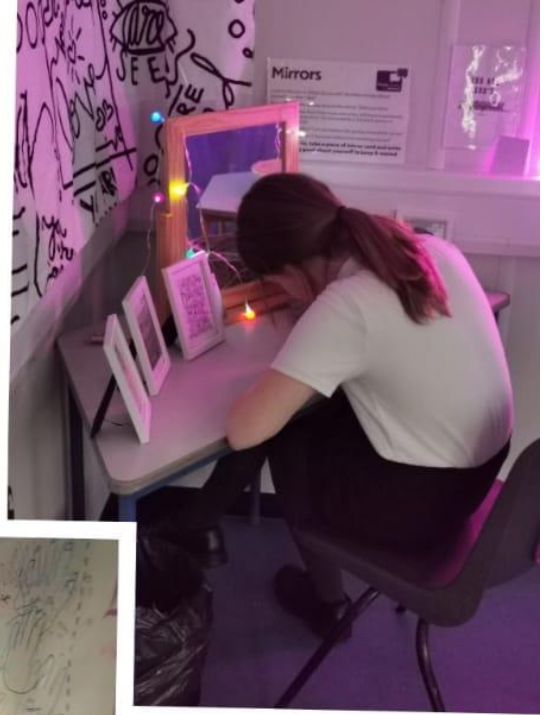
## RSPB Big Schools Bird Watch
