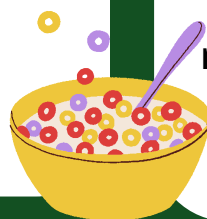
Year 3 - Please remember to bring your reply slip in for the Wingham trip on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October by Monday, if you haven't already done so.

At St Peter's School, we believe that our Christian values stem from love - the love God has for us, that we have for God and that we show each other. This is reflected through:

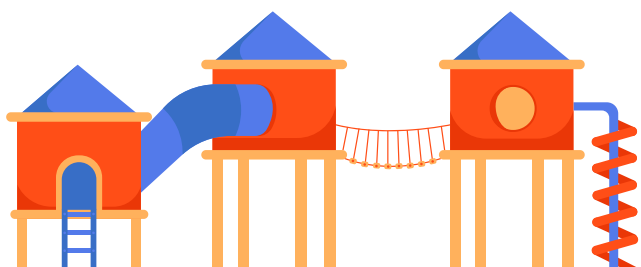
