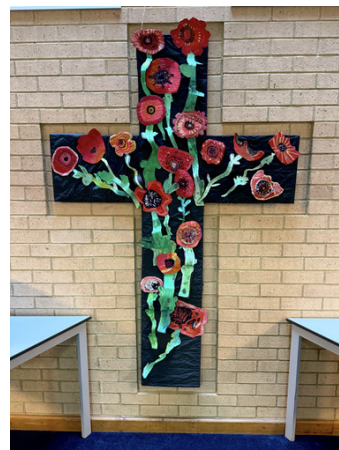
Remembrance Day
