Roblox

We have received some important information regarding Roblox so, if your child uses this, it is important that you read this message.

It is being reported that some children are receiving 'pop up' messages on Roblox asking them to download an app called 'Pollyfuzz' (an AI friend). This leads to the children being asked questions which generates an AI friend for them.

Although starting innocently, over time, this character then talks and engages in unsafe ways with them on Roblox.

This is obviously extremely dangerous which is why we wanted to bring this to your attention.

We hope that in doing so and continuing to share information like this with you, we can all help to keep children safe.

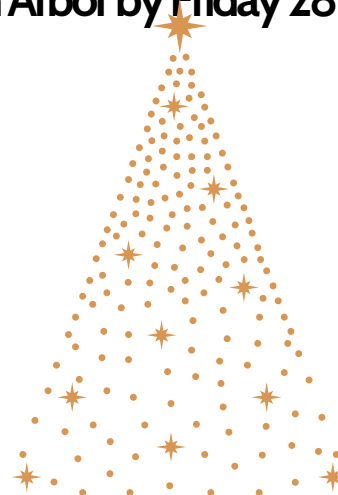

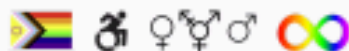
