



## Written statement of behaviour principles

- Every pupil understands that they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and learn free from the disruption of others.
- All pupils, staff and visitors have the right to be free from any form of discrimination.
- All staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times.
- Strategies to manage behaviour are consistently used by staff
- The Positive Engagement policy is shared and understood by pupils, parents and staff.
- Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions.
- Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life.
- Exclusions will only be used as a last resort.

The Governing Body also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
