Clubs begin on Tuesday 6th January 2026

Clubs run straight from school at 3.15pm and finish at 4.30pm unless otherwise stated in the programme. All clubs cost **£3.50** per session. Charges still apply if a child is absent for any reason. Clubs can only be swapped in the first 2 weeks of Term 3 and only if there is space.

All clubs run for two terms.

Should your child choose to leave a club during or after Term 3, payment is still required for Term 4 as spaces will have been allocated.

Payment for clubs MUST be received before your child can start to attend the sessions as we are not allowed to give credit.

Clubs may be changed but we try not to cancel them, regardless of the weather. This is with the exception of Squad clubs, as on occasions Mr Allen has to take pupils to competitions and covering Squad clubs when a sports coach is needed is not always possible. We will always offer childcare if we have to cancel.

While we understand that there are occasions when parents are held up and arrive late, prompt collection is compulsory and a **fee of £5.00 per 1/4 hour will be incurred for late collection of any child.**

Although we try to ensure as many children as possible receive their choice of clubs, some will be oversubscribed. Allocations are finalised by our school cloud system to ensure as many children as possible receive their first choices. **Don't forget to make your choices in good time, so the process can run smoothly.**

This is not decided on a first come first served basis.

Any children who don't receive their first choice can be added to the waiting list for that club if requested.

Please help us to ensure clubs are successful by making sure that:

- Children are happy with the choices they have made, to limit the number of changes asked for.
- Children have the correct kit/clothing and footwear in order to take part.
- Children are collected promptly at 4.30pm.
- Parents inform the office or Mrs Coyne if your child will not be attending clubs.

Absences must be reported prior to sessions starting by the parent/guardian using the contact details below.

Please do not ask your child to let us know they are not going to be at club. We need to hear from a parent/guardian either by txt, phone call, Arbor or via the office, otherwise a phone call home will be made to verify the child's whereabouts.

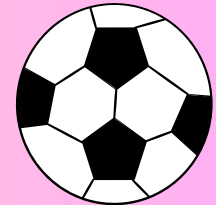
