



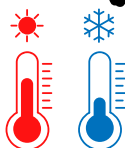

- Healthy Eating and Lifestyle

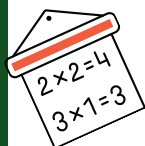

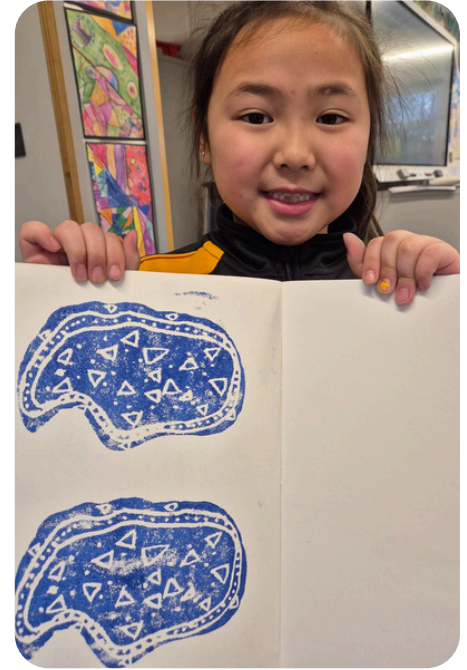
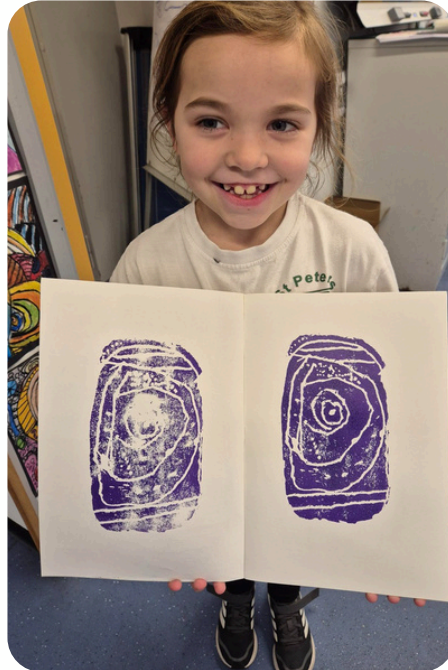
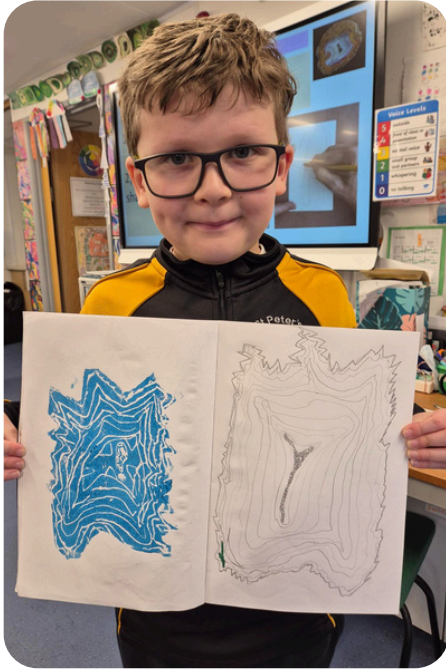




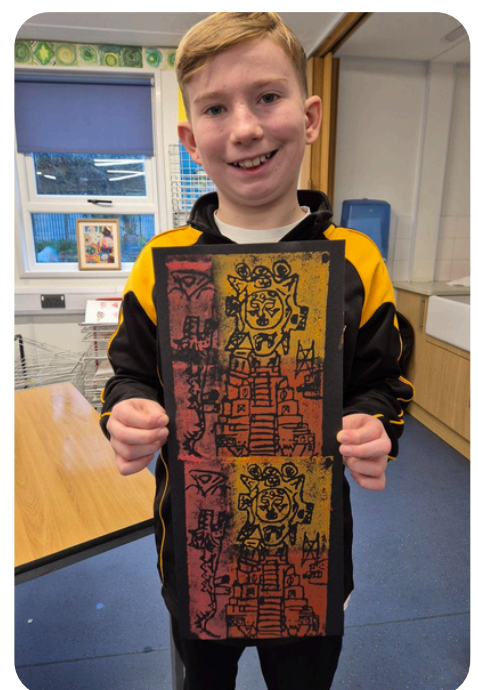
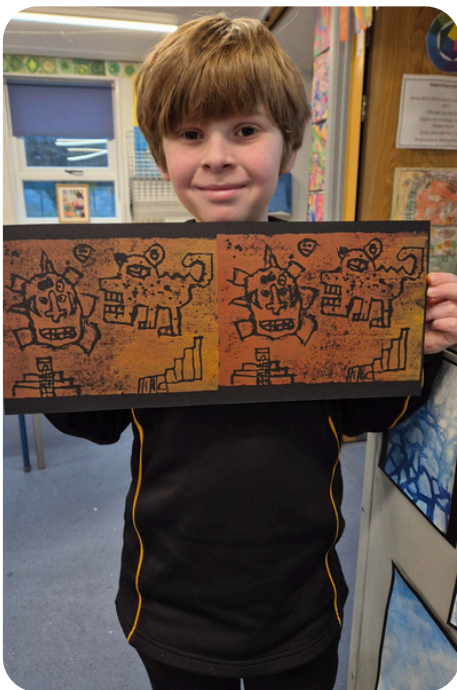
This week's Art masterpieces!

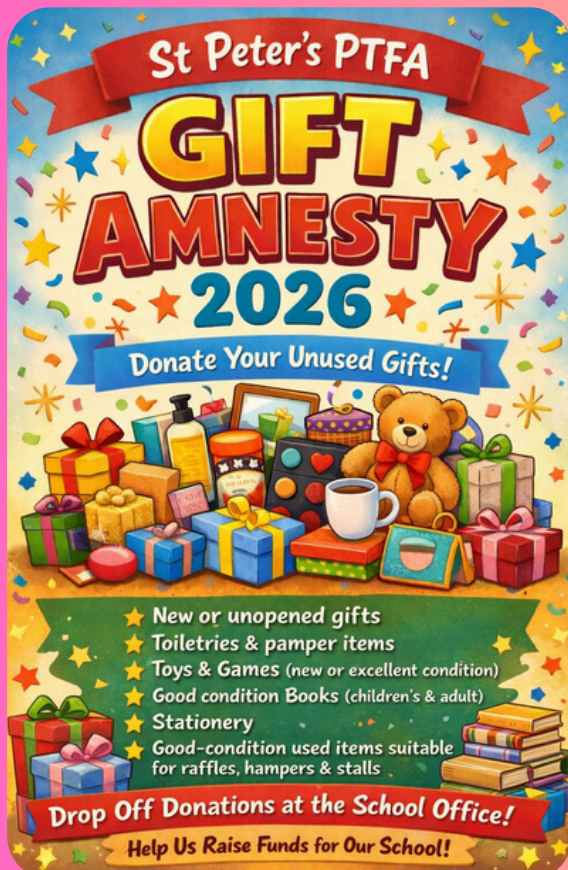
