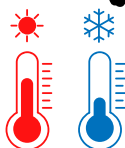

Please can we remind all parents and pupils that scooters and bikes **MUST NOT** be ridden on the school grounds.



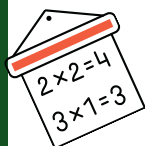
Earlier this week, a St. Peter's pupil was knocked over on the playground, at the end of the school day, by another pupil on their scooter.

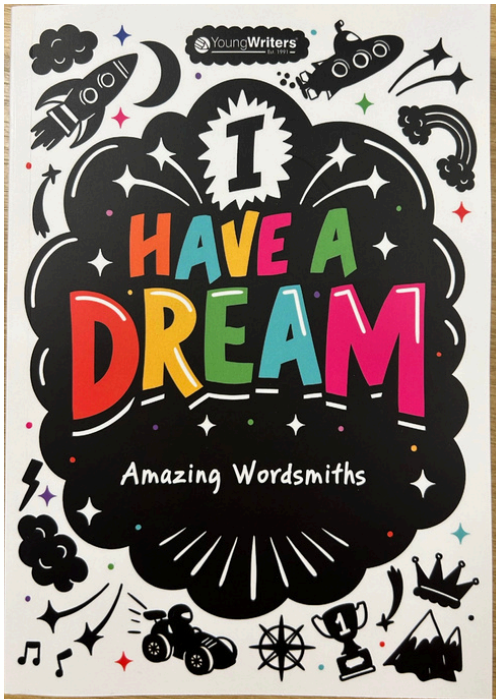

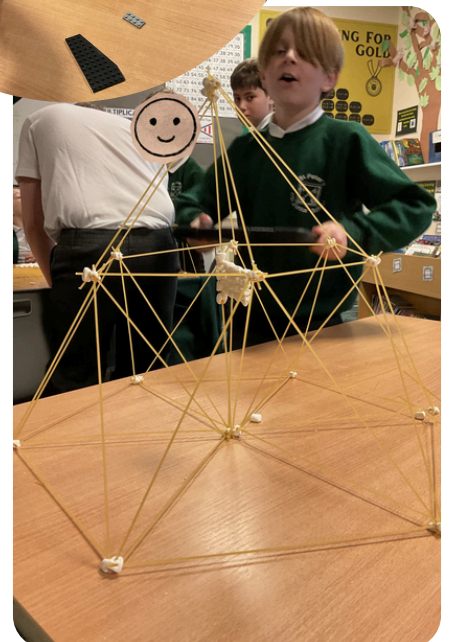
# Rugby

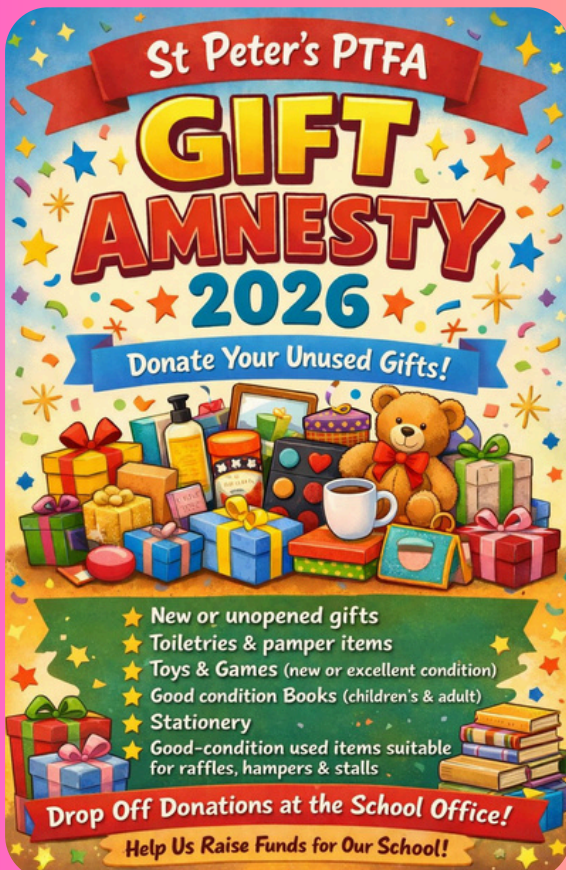

Tickets are priced at £4 per child and includes a drink and a snack.





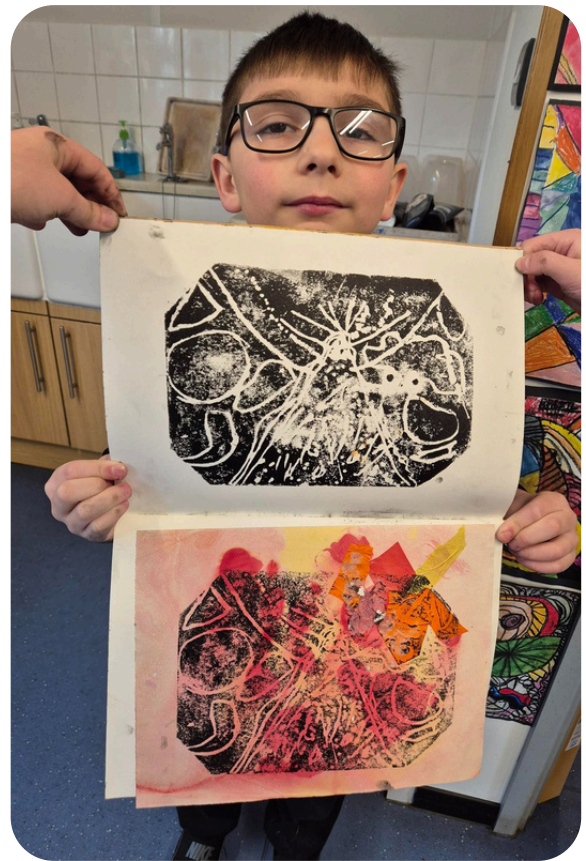
# Star of the week!
