Happy Easter

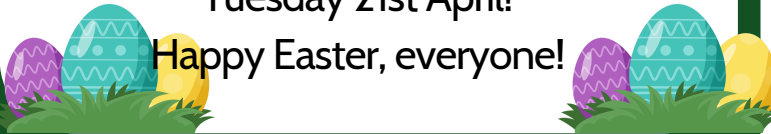


After a very busy term, the Easter holidays are here!

5S: Esme B - for being an amazing member of the class and ALWAYS showing the 3 R's.

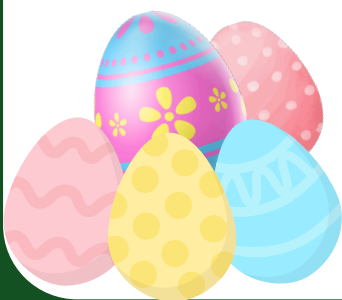
5L: Rex W - for always being such a kind and helpful individual.
