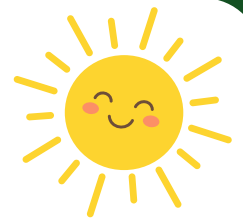

Our St Peter's Weekly Weather Report!

Using our incredible weather station, each week we are reporting a comparison in the weather at St Peter's and a different location around the world.

Year 3 - St Peter's and different locations in the UK

Monday: 3L	On Monday 1st of June there was no rainfall in St Peter's. However, yesterday on Thursday 4th June there was 9.5mm of rain in St Peter's across the day which meant WET PLAY!
Wednesday: 3B	Wow! What a day weather wise. We had 89 mins of rain in St Peter's with a total of 3.1mm of rain fall.
Friday: 3S	On Friday, there is a 10% chance of rain at school. In Leeds, there is a 0% chance of rain today so they are unlikely to have any.

Year 4 - St Peter's and different locations in Europe

Monday: 4B	
Tuesday: 4S	In Sorreno in Italy it was 23C. Broadstairs was 11C colder
Thursday: 4W	We were suprised to see that In Vencie there was no wind at all where as in St Peter's we had a wind speed of 3.6mph. It was also ten degrees warmer in Vencie than it was in St peter's

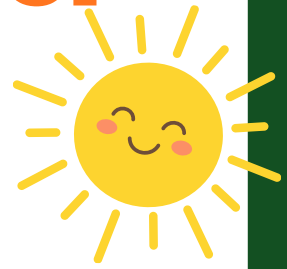
Year 5 - St Peter's and different locations in Africa and Asia

Monday: 5S	On Monday, the average temperature in Broadstairs and Nairobi was very similliar, with Nairobi only being 0.6 degrees warmer.
Tuesday: 5L	On Tuesday, the average temperature in Broadstairs was 15.3 degrees. In Mombasa, the temperature averaged 24.5 degrees.
Thursday: 5BN	On Thursday, the rainfall was recorded as 9.3mm, however in Saudi Arabia it was only 0.7mm.

Year 6 - St Peter's and different locations in North America, South America and Antarctica

Tuesday: 6I	
Wednesday: 6WG	This term we are looking into the history of St Peter's so we compared the weather today with the same date in 1996. Today temperature was 16 degrees and that was exactly the same on the 3rd June 1996.
Friday: 6A	The humidity in Broadstairs today is currently at 71%. We noticed that this time last year the humidity was similar at 76%.
