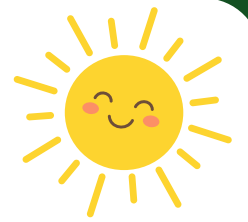

Bee hive

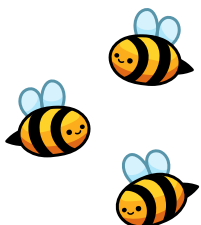


Science Club has been hard at work preparing for some very special new arrivals!

They also visited Discovery Park where they attended the Science Jamboree.



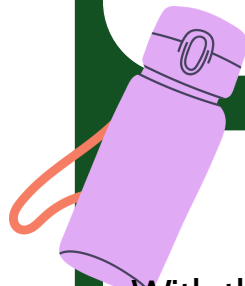
Correct uniform

We would like to remind all parents and carers that pupils should attend school wearing the correct school uniform, including the appropriate PE kit on PE days.

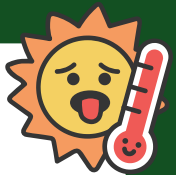
Please note that make-up, nail varnish, and jewellery should not be worn in school. These items are not part of our uniform policy.

Lunch with a Scientist

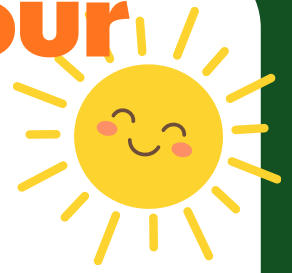
