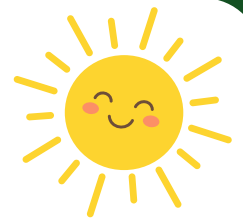
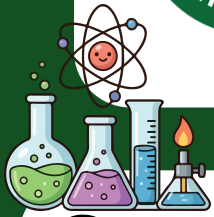

# Our St Peter's Weekly Weather Report!

Using our incredible weather station, each week we are reporting a comparison in the weather at St Peter's and a different location around the world.

## Year 3 - St Peter's and different locations in the UK

Monday: 3L	In St Peter's today we have had 1mm of rainfall. It rained a lot after lunchtime but has now stopped at 2:26pm. However in Belfast, Northern Ireland, they have had no rain today at all but did have 4.4mm yesterday.
Wednesday: 3B	There has been 43 lightning strikes detected in the last 3 hours from St Peter's, 0-3km away. However, no lightning was detected in Edinbrugh, Scotland.
Friday: 3S	2 days ago, lightning was detected at our weather station as we had a thunderstorm. In the Falkland Islands, lightning was detected 25 days ago!

## Year 4 - St Peter's and different locations in Europe

Monday: 4B	In Broadstairs, the temperature was 17 degrees C with heavy showers. In Sorrento, Italy, the weather was 26 degrees C and sunny.
Tuesday: 4S	In Sorrento in Italy it was a lovely 25.5C and sunny. Here in Broadstairs it was 16C with a chance of rain.
Thursday: 4W	It has been a very wet week in St Peter's where we have had a total of 42.7mm of rain whereas in Venice it has not rained all week.

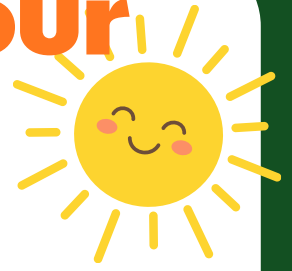
## Year 5 - St Peter's and different locations in Africa and Asia

Monday: 5S	On Monday, in Broadstairs, 3.6mm of rain fell over 171 minutes. In Mombasa, the same amount of rain fell but over only 19 minutes! There were also 5 lightning strikes recorded in Broadstairs but 0 in Mombasa.
Tuesday: 5L	On Tuesday, it rained for 28 minutes in Mombasa. In Broadstairs, it rained for 56 minutes - Exactly double the amount in Mombasa!
Thursday: 5BN	On Thursday in Broadstairs, the rainfall was recorded as 5.5mm. In Egypt, it was recorded as only a trace!

## Year 6 - St Peter's and different locations in North America, South America and Antarctica

Tuesday: 6I	After the lightning strikes we saw this week, we looked back at Antarctica (from our topic last term) and noticed that the Antarctic had experienced 213 lightning strikes in last 3 hours!!!!
Wednesday: 6WG	
Friday: 6A	We have been lucky today for our football event. There has been 0 minutes of rain. Had the event been yesterday then it would have been more challenging as there were 185 minutes of rain recorded at St Peter's.
